NEEDS:

- Citizens, anglers and anyone willing to pick up trash left on the ice.
- Trash bags will be distributed at participating accesses from Springsteel to Wheelers Point.
- Trash can be placed at dumpsters at participating accesses.
- This event is weather dependent. We hope to have most of the snow melted, and safe ice. We may have to postpone the event a week for right conditions. Watch local papers.

WHY:

Ice fishing on Lake of the Woods is an important economic resource for the county. The winter ice fishing season of 2011 – 2012 proved to be one of the trashiest years for winter anglers on LOW. In the spring, before ice melt but after snow melt, the lake looked like a sea of garbage bags full of trash. The “Friends of Zippel Bay State Park” picked up over 5 truckloads of trash and waste on a small stretch of beach in Zippel Bay State Park.



Volunteers are needed to:

- **Go out on the ice and pick up trash**
 - Whether you want to spend some time on the lake picking up trash or just pick up garbage on your way out to your hot spot, all participation is welcome!
